REACH Declaration of Conformity

Registration must take place for manufacturers and importers of chemicals. The registration requirement does not apply to any products; also downstream users, including formulators, do not have to register.

Our raw material suppliers informed us, that all the raw materials we need to manufacture our products are pre-registered or registered.

The information obligation in art. 33 refers to products for the consumer, but not on substances, mixtures or partial products. The products delivered by us are process chemicals. Therefore art. 33 does not apply to our products.

Information on SVHC can be found in the safety data sheets of our products. If a substance gets on the SVHC list, the safety data sheet is automatically updated accordingly and sent to all customers without being asked.

Subject to authorisation are substances, but not mixtures, partial products or products. It is the duty of **each user** to check whether the intended use is properly licensed.

If a substance is subject to authorisation, we will ensure that our suppliers consider the uses on application for authorisation which are known to us.

The ECHA plans to check between 2013 and 2020 up to 440 substances as SVHC. Due to the number of materials we are not able to inform our customers in advance.

If a substance is on the SVHC list, there is an automatic note in the corresponding safety data sheet.
